Dual Enrollment Courses

- x UIW core courses and lower division courses within a declared pathway are eligible for dual enrollment. Courses offered at the School of Professional Studies are not eligible for dual enrollment.
- x All eligible courses are taught by UIW faculty with the same syllabus, materials, and rigor as any other section taught on the campus.
- x The availability of dual enrollment courses is determined by demand, course cycles, and compatible meeting times.
- x The student is responsible for contacting the prospective secondary institution to determine whether courses taken at UIW are transferable.
- x Courses are taught on the UIW main campus either in person or online and consist of a combination of high school and undergraduate student classes that are taught online may consist of synchronous or asynchronous instruction.

Grades and Transcripts

- x All grades earned at UIW become part of the student's permanent college record.
- x A student who fails to earn a minimum 2.0 C term grade in each enrolled course at the end of the semester may lose their eligibility to continue in the Early College Program.
- x The student's grade point average earned while at UIW may affect their eligibility for future college scholarships and financial aid availability.
- x It is the student's responsibility to communicate directly with their instructors regarding course expectations and grades.

Registration and Enrollment
