Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination

Texas state law mandates that all students under the age of 22 entering a Texas college or university provide proof of vaccination against bacterial meningitis. Students must submit this documentation prior to registering for classes and the vaccine must be administered. Submit their vaccination record in PDF form to the Office of the Registrar at registrar@uiwtx.edu.

Vehicle Parking Permit

Students may register their vehicle using the T2 Cardinal Cars app via UIW's Cardinal Apps sign-on portal. Bring the required items to orientation in order to register for a parking permit. Visit uiw.edu/parking for more information.

- Valid email address (your student will be required to verify their account using this email)
- Vehicle license plate number and state
- Vehicle make, model, color and style

Health Insurance Waiver

All UIW students must have medical insurance. If your student is already insured on a family plan, make sure to waive coverage by the first day of the semester to avoid charges.

Students must pay tuition or enroll in a payment plan before the semester begins. Once students have registered for classes, they may enroll in a payment plan on CashNet via Cardinal Apps. Visit uiw.edu/busoff for more information.
