VA PROCESSING

After registering for any classes, complete the UIW Veterans Certification Form

Add/Drops must be reported to our office by the student via the UIW Veterans Certification Request form

Dropped courses can result in a school debt for the student, especially when it comes to banded tuition. All students need to contact our office prior to finalizing drops.

Billing – Billing for VA Chapters 30, 31, and 33 is done after the add/drop date for each term/semester.

To receive full stipend and housing allowance, students need to be enrolled in 12 credit hours full semester. With at least one class in person or Hybrid.

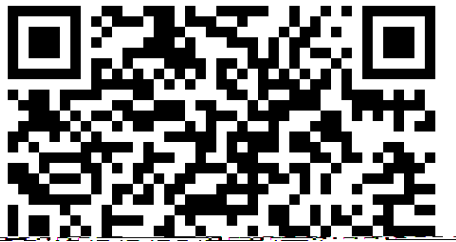
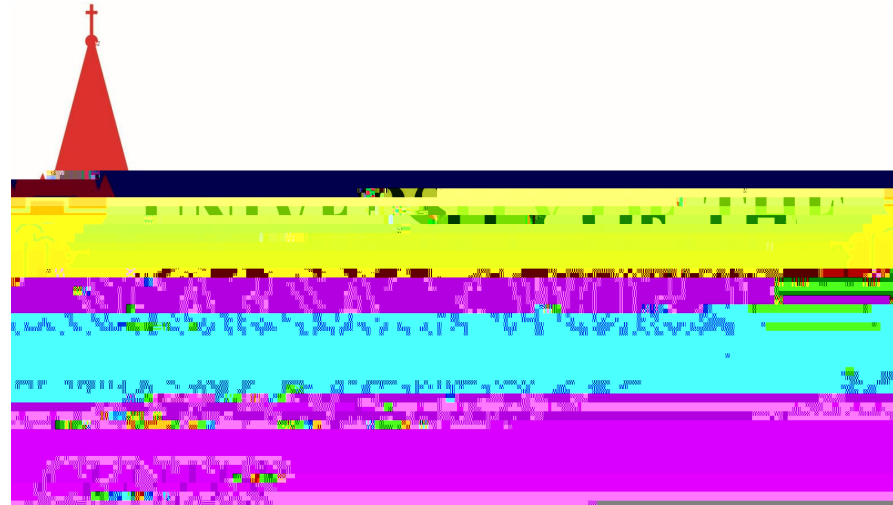
PROGRAMS & RESOURCES
