- x Use scholarship search engines (e.g., FastWeb.com), but make sure never to pay money to find scholarships and be cautious what persoint mation you are sharing online.
- x Research different scholarship opportunities en if they don't pertain to your major. Applying to multiple scholarships may result in more awawdsich adds up!
