| <b>Student VISA (mandatory)</b>     | Students are required to obtain a Student Visa at the Consular Office in their home country. Necessary documentation will be sent in June for Fall students and December for Spring students. It is mandatory to obtain your student VISA. Contact your closest Consular Office for further information.   |
| <b>Housing</b>                      | UCA does not provide housing on campus. UCA has no agreements with Housing Providers or Students 'Houses. Each student should seek its own housing option. We recommend students to book a hostel for the first weeks and rent their housing after being onsite.   |
| <b>Health Insurance (mandatory)</b> | International and exchange students must bring medical insurance from their home countries or hire a local medical coverage. This is a mandatory requirement at UCA. We recommend students to make sure that this Insurance covers emergency hospitalization, general check-ups with a doctor and repatriation as well. Students will need to provide us with a copy of the health insurance before the course registration. Further COVID-19 requirements will apply. |
